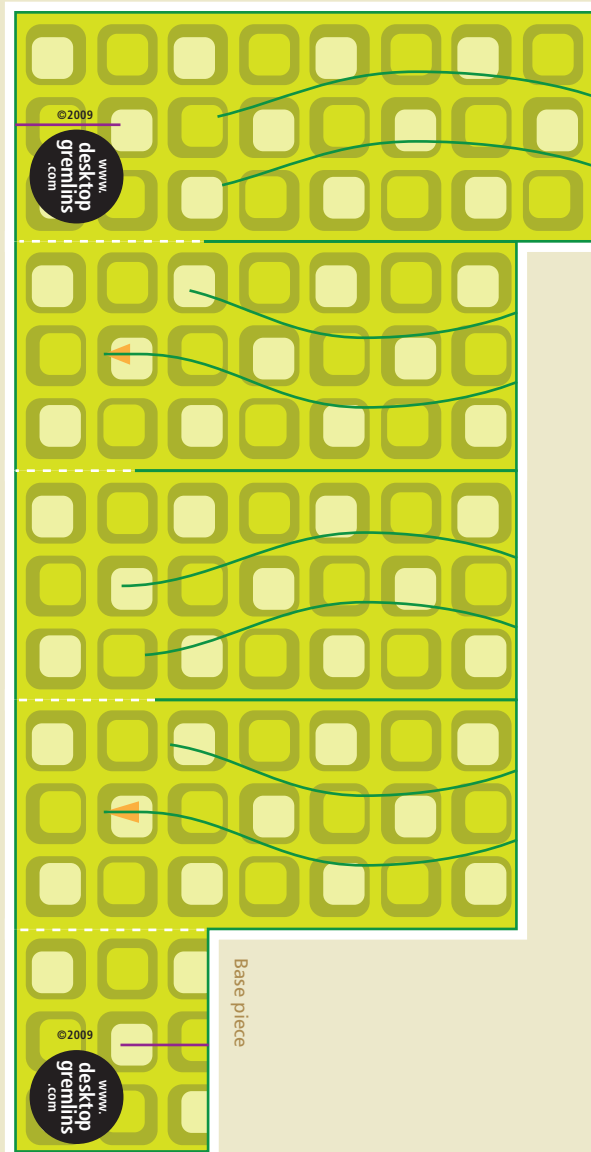

**Notes:** This sculpture uses some FOLD lines. So don't cut through the dashed white lines on the "base" piece.



Base piece

See how you rotated this page around to read this text more easily? **Ge** The same rule applies to scissor cutting. Rotate the **Whiz!** PAPER while cutting—not the scissors—and you'll get pro-looking edges (and impress your friends!).

**INSTRUCTIONS**  
1) Trim out the 2 pieces that form your gremlin (GRAY border on the "base" piece). Don't forget to cut the assembly slots in each piece. 2) Fold the "base" piece on the WHITE dashed lines and form a square-type shape by sliding the two vertical PURPLE slots into each other. 3) Now is your chance to be creative with the "base" piece and curl the paper in lots of random ways to make the base look torn and tattered. 4) Insert the "Character" into the "base" by aligning the ORANGE markings.

COLLECT THEM ALL!



The "Booty Snatcher" (also known as a gift mimic) is a mysterious mischief maker. We're not even sure where the actual body of the gremlin ends and its clever use of camouflage begins. What is known however is the snatcher's voracious appetite for sweets and its love of swiping gifts from people to add to its arsenal of clever costumes. BEWARE - unleash this monstrosity with caution. If you try really hard you may be able to train him to clean your messes. Be sure to hide one on a friend's desk and watch the chaos!
