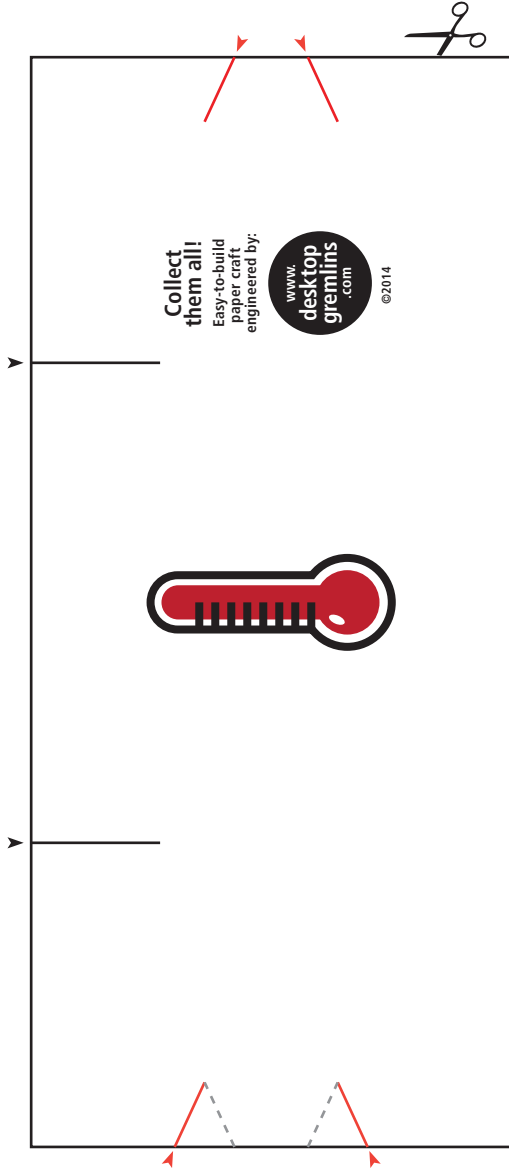

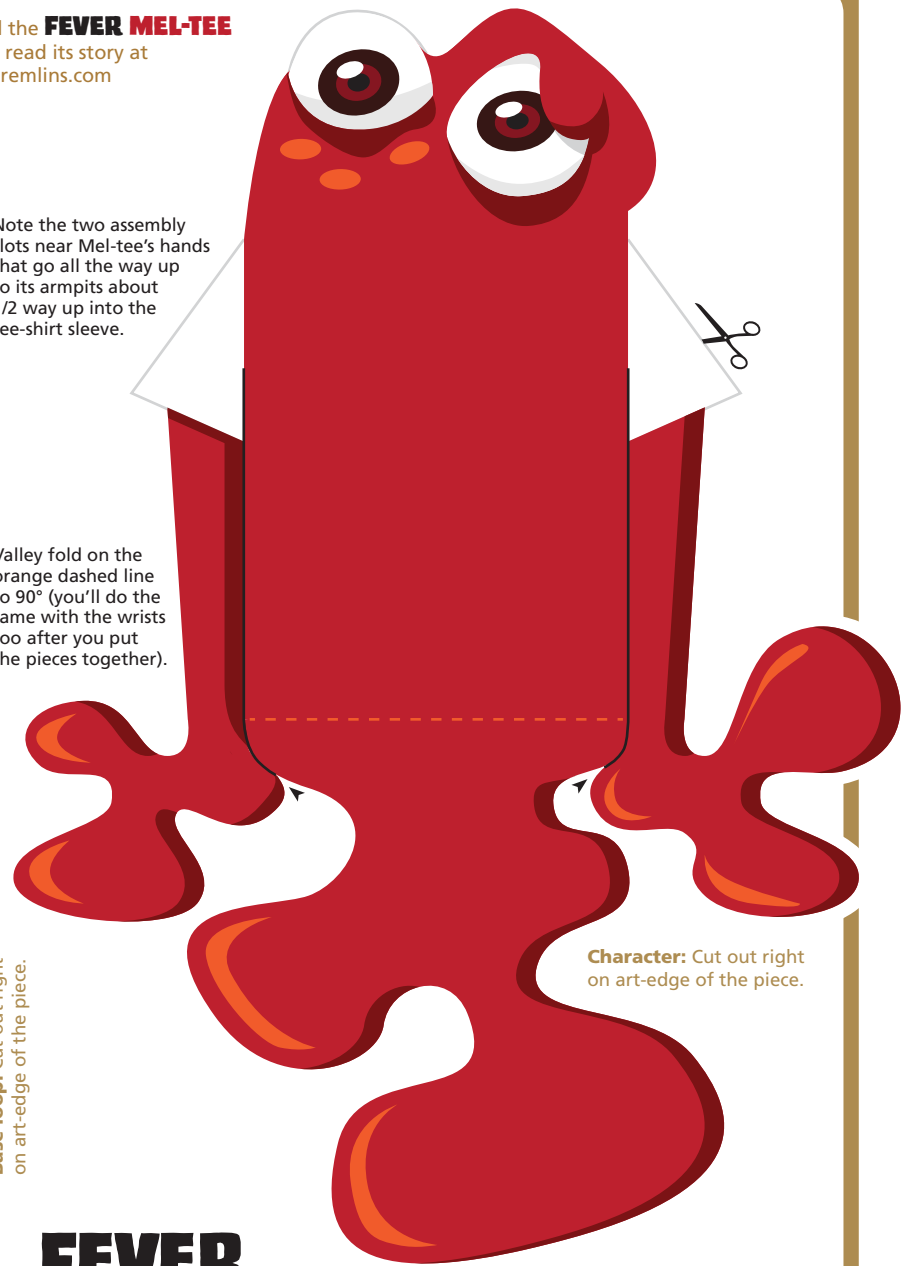


Collect them all!

Note the two assembly slots near Mel-tee's hands that go all the way up to its armpits about 1/2 way up into the tee-shirt sleeve.

Valley fold on the orange dashed line to 90° (you'll do the same with the wrists too after you put the pieces together).

Base loop: Cut out right on art-edge of the piece.



Character: Cut out right on art-edge of the piece.

FEVER MEL-TEE

BUTTERFLY LOCK: Cut on the red assembly slots and mountain fold on the gray dashed lines to make this end look like this...



Push this end into the assembly slots on the opposite end of this piece and then open the tabs back up so it locks in place.

STEP 1: Print your construction sheet with your desktop printer on glossy photo paper or 65 lb. card stock paper for best results.

STEP 2: Cut out each piece as indicated with scissors. Don't forget to cut the color-coded assembly slots on each piece (indicated by small arrowheads and solid lines).

STEP 3: Assemble as shown. No glue, no tape, no knives required!
