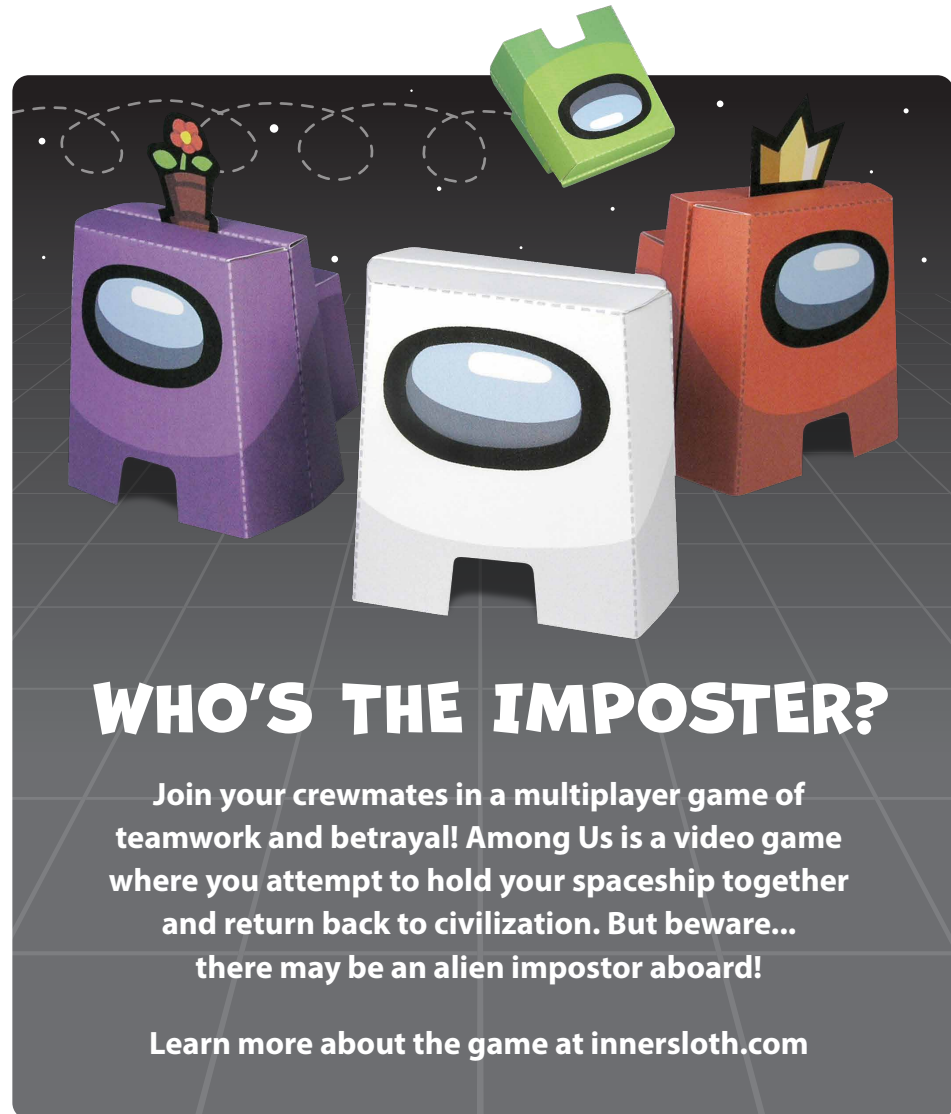

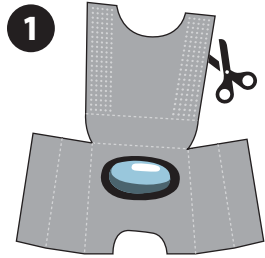


WHO'S THE IMPOSTER?

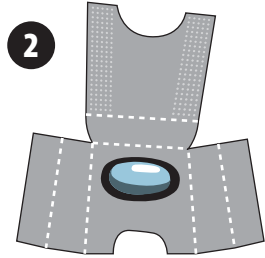

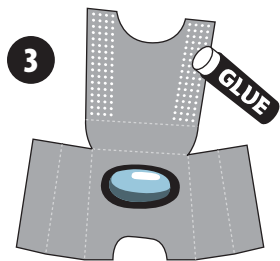

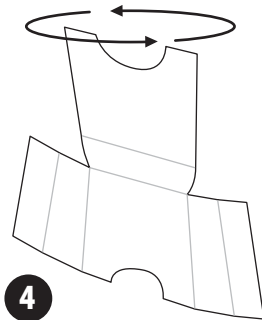

 Carefully cut out the front piece with scissors.



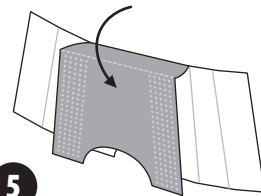

 Fold the shape on all the dashed lines to create creases, then flatten out again.



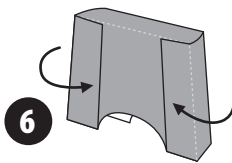

 Fold over the center panel along your pre-made creases.

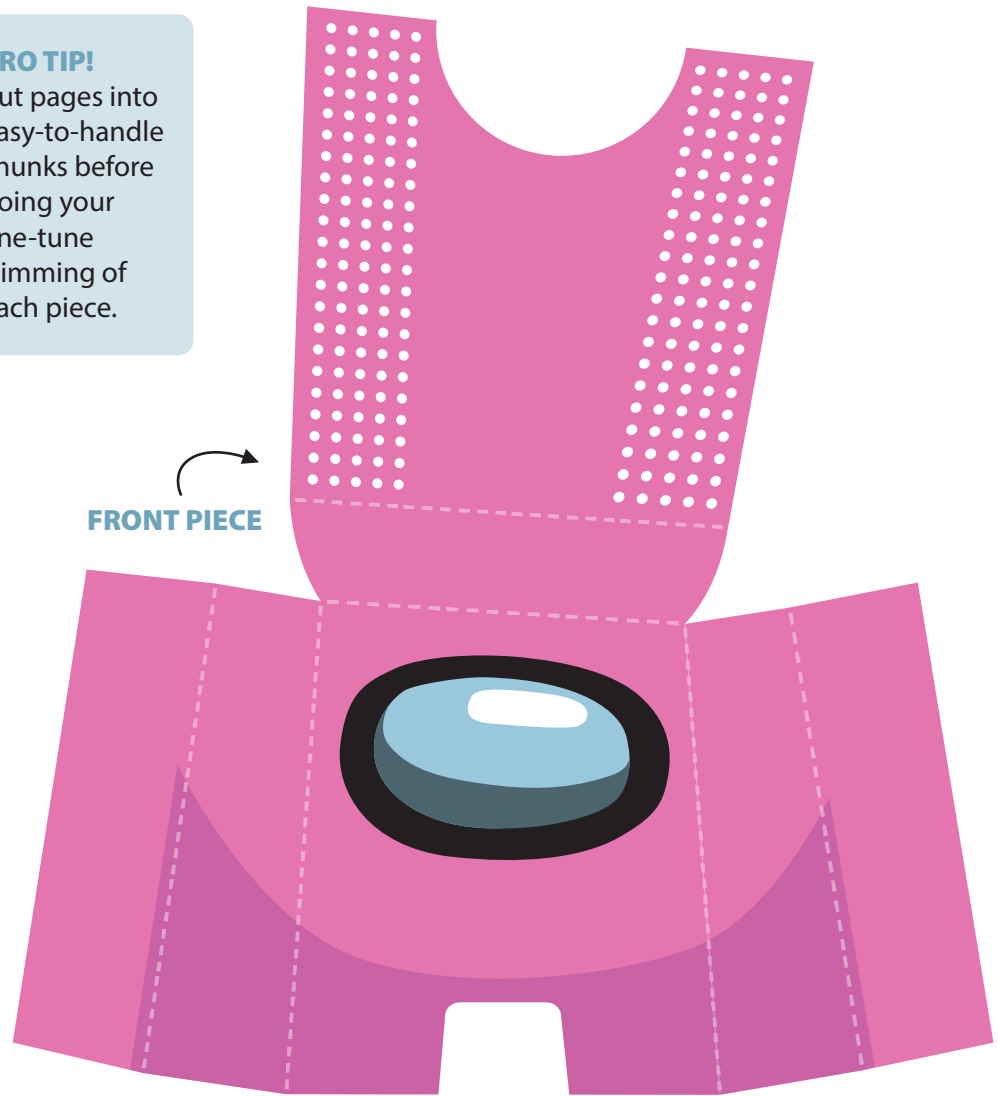


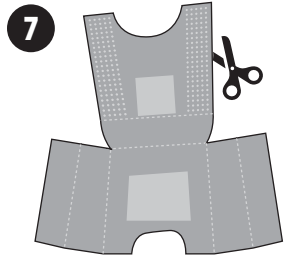

PRO TIP!

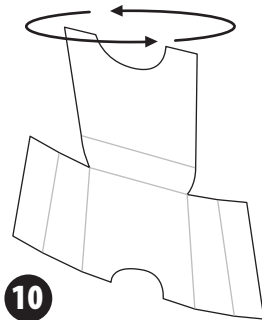
Cut pages into easy-to-handle chunks before doing your fine-tune trimming of each piece.

FRONT PIECE

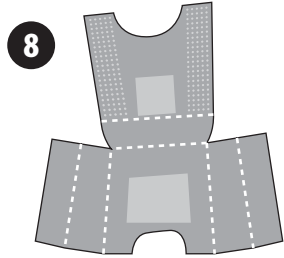




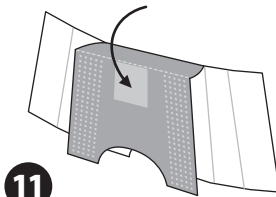

Carefully cut out the back piece with scissors.



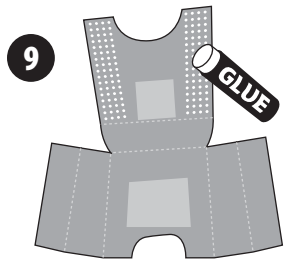

Pick the piece up and turn it over to its blank side. You should be able to see the crease indentions from step 8.



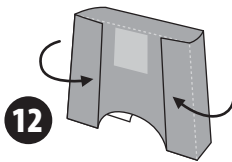

Fold the shape on all the dashed lines to create creases, then flatten out again.



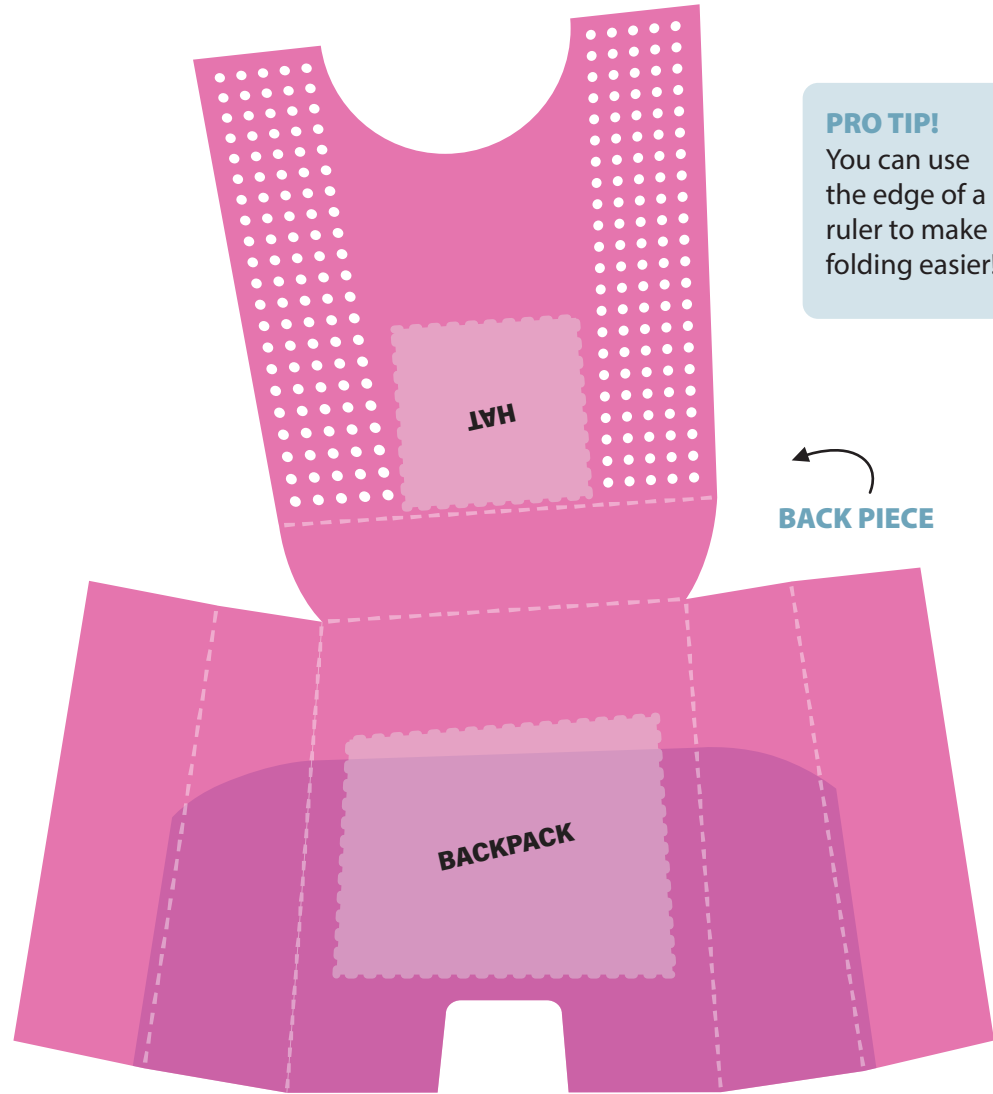

Using a glue stick, apply glue on these dotted areas.



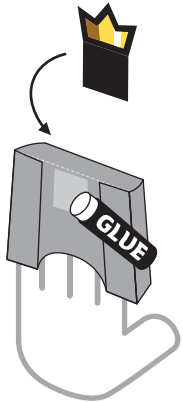

You can use the edge of a ruler to make folding easier!

Optional! Does your Crewmate want a hat?

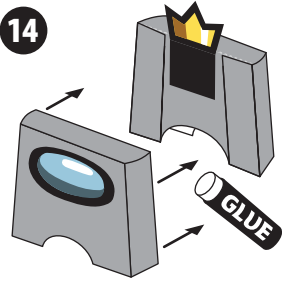


The BACK PIECE has labels showing you where to glue the accent pieces in place. Just use the words to match things up like a puzzle.

PRO TIP!

You can slide the back piece over your hand like a mitten to make gluing easier!

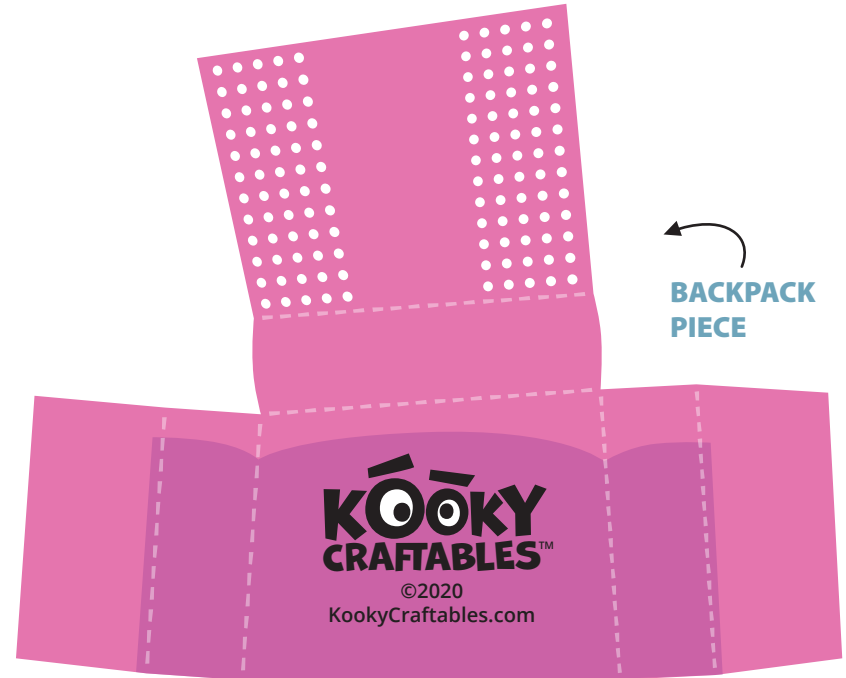
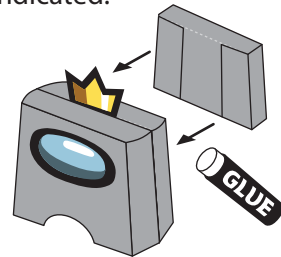

Add glue to the interior sides of the front and back pieces and "sandwich" them together.

The final step is to cut, fold, and glue the Crewmate's backpack into its boxy shape using the same method as you used for the front and back pieces. Then glue it to the back of your Crewmate where indicated!
