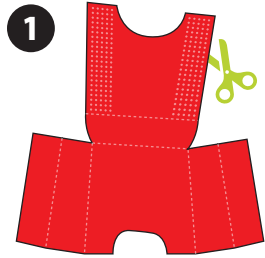

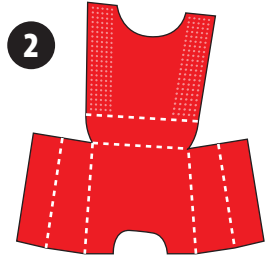


## HO-HO-HO!

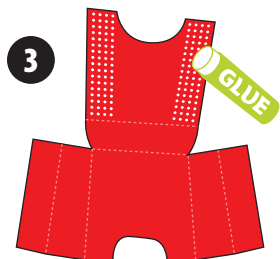

Thank goodness you're here, because Santa needs help to spread Christmas cheer. So grab your scissors and a little glue. Who's naughty? Who's nice? It's all up to YOU!



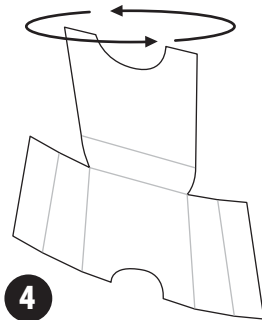
**1**  
 Carefully cut out the front piece with scissors.



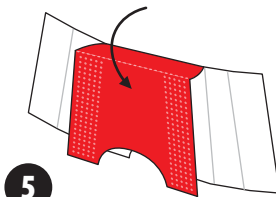
**2**  
 Fold the shape on all the dashed lines to create creases, then flatten out again.



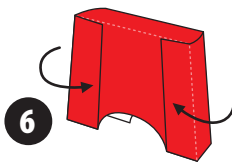
**3**  
 Using a glue stick, apply glue on these dotted areas.



**4**  
 Pick the piece up and turn it over to its blank side. You should be able to see the crease indentions from step 2.



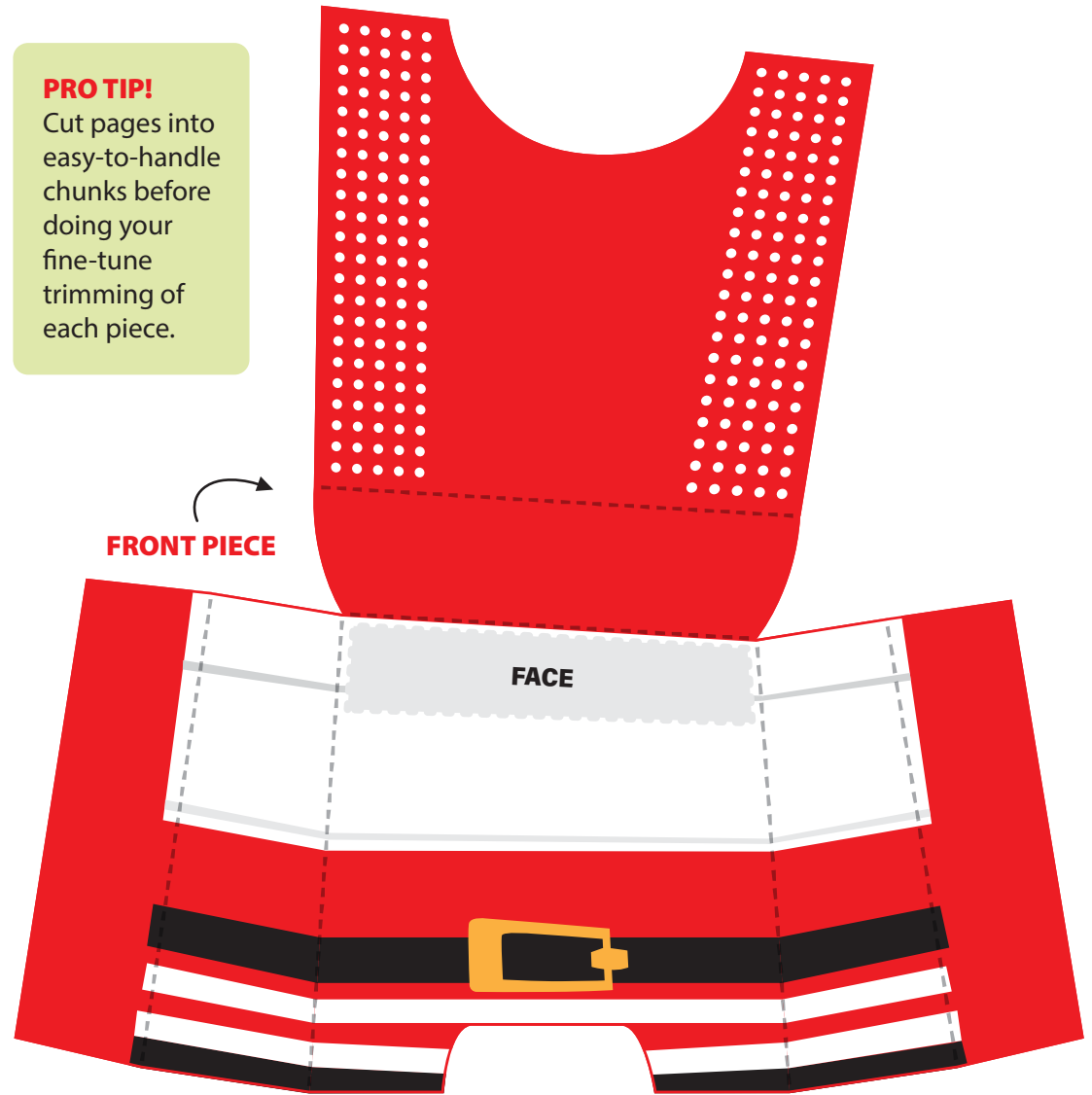
**5**  
 Fold over the center panel along your pre-made creases.

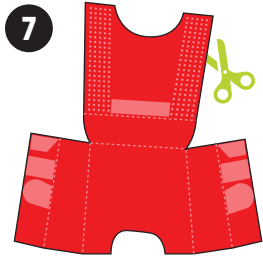


**6**  
 Fold over the side flaps and affix to glued areas, being mindful not to crush the boxy shape of the front piece.

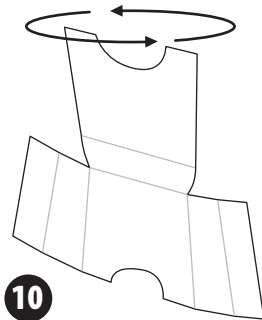
**PRO TIP!**

Cut pages into easy-to-handle chunks before doing your fine-tune trimming of each piece.

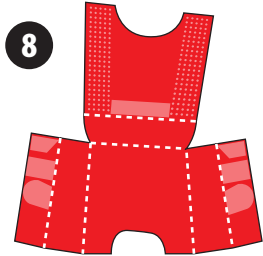




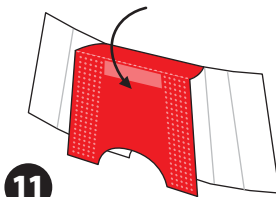
**7**  
Carefully cut out the back piece with scissors.



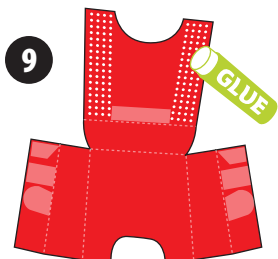
**10**  
Pick the piece up and turn it over to its blank side. You should be able to see the crease indentions from step 2.



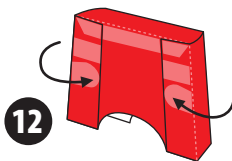
**8**  
Fold the shape on all the dashed lines to create creases, then flatten out again.

Fold over the center panel along your pre-made creases.

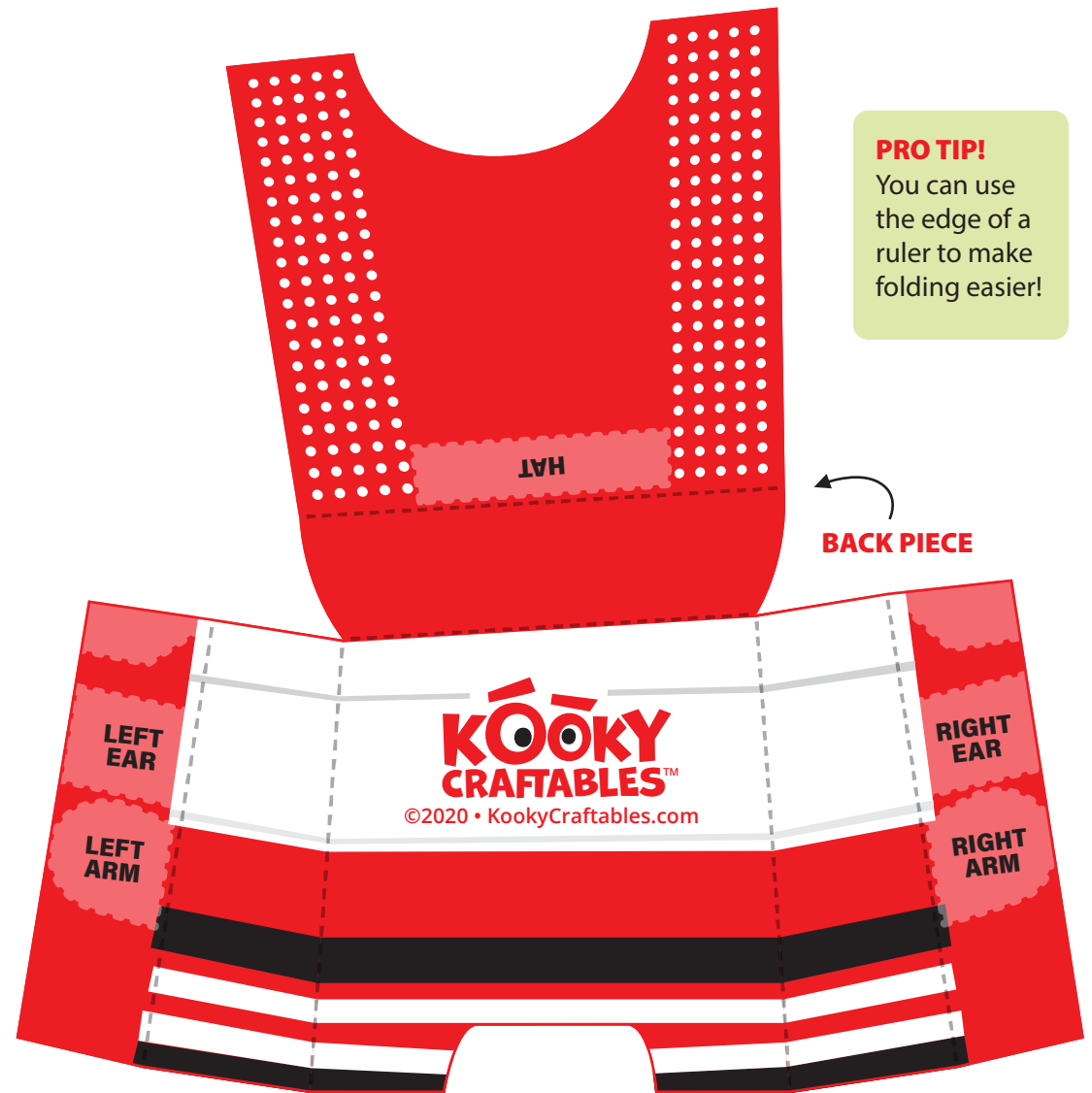


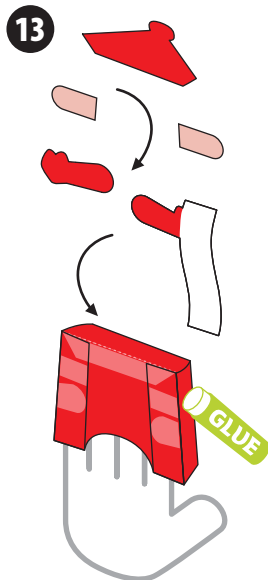
**9**  
Using a glue stick, apply glue on these dotted areas.

Fold over the side flaps and affix to glued areas, being mindful not to crush the boxy shape of the front piece.

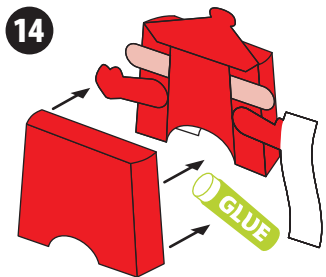
**PRO TIP!**  
You can use the edge of a ruler to make folding easier!





The BACK PIECE has labels showing you where to glue the accent pieces in place. Just use the words to match things up like a puzzle.

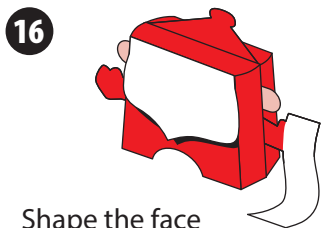
**PRO TIP!**  
You can slide the back piece over your hand like a mitten to make gluing easier!



Add glue to the interior sides of the front and back pieces and “sandwich” them together.

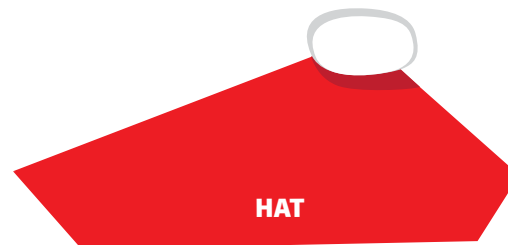


Attach the face piece with glue.



Shape the face piece and the “list” in his left hand to add some additional dimension to your completed Kooky Craftables masterpiece!
