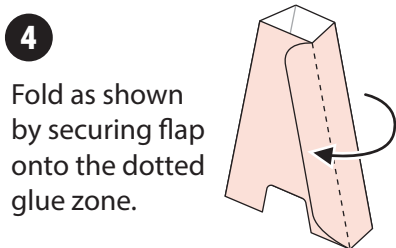
Carefully cut out the **BODY BACK** piece with scissors.



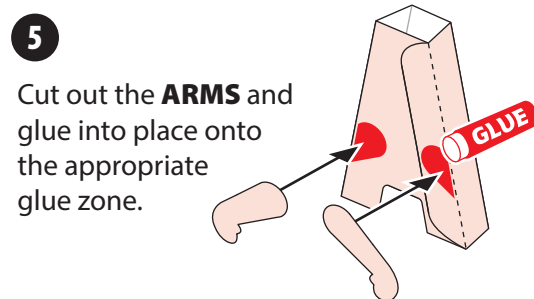
Make crisp folds on all dashed lines to create creases, then flatten out the shape again.



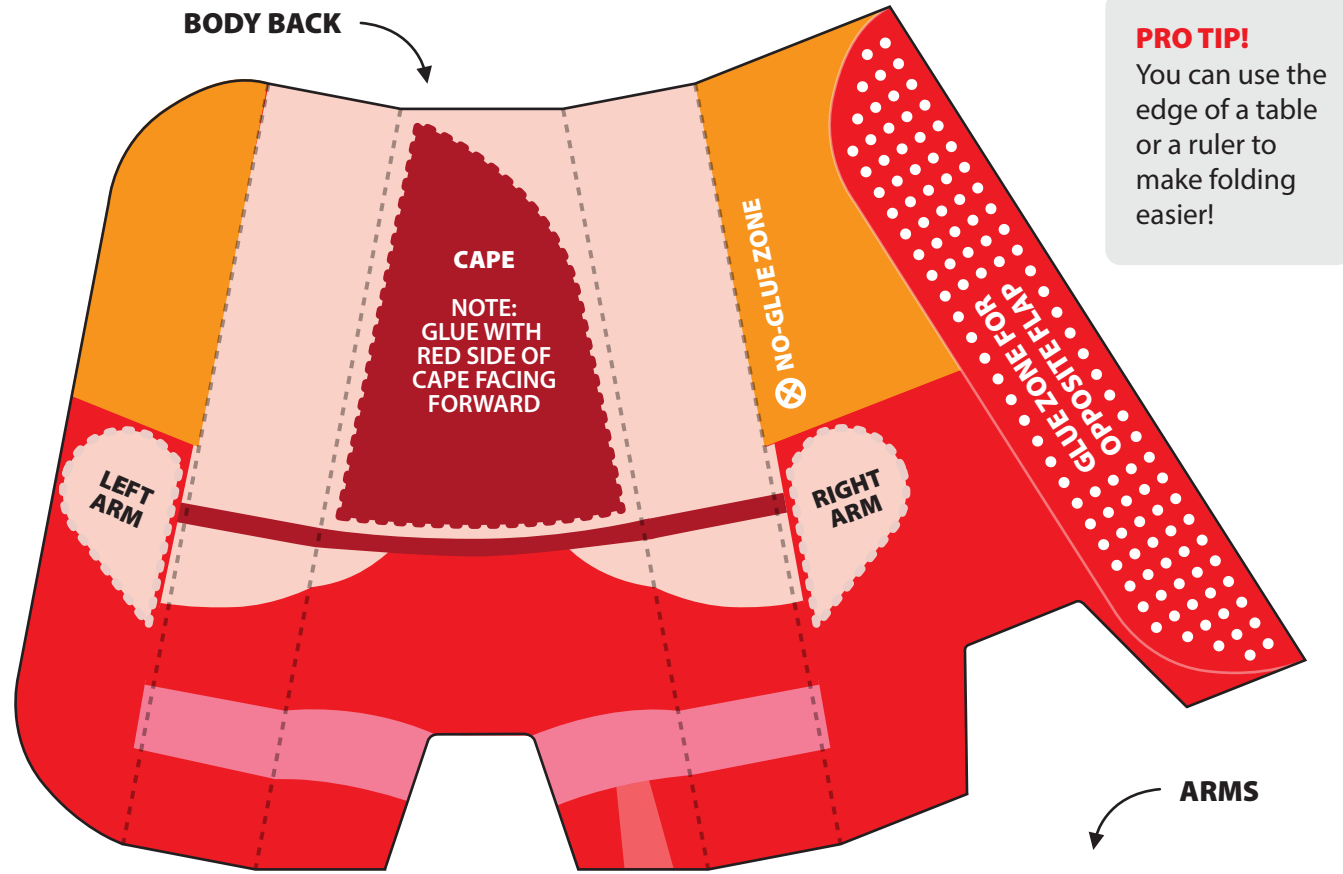
Using a glue stick, apply glue on the dotted glue zone.



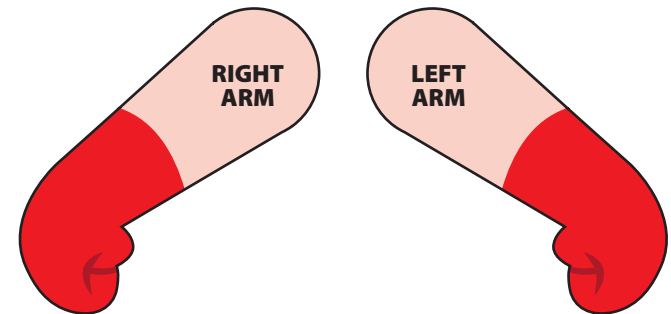
Fold as shown by securing flap onto the dotted glue zone.



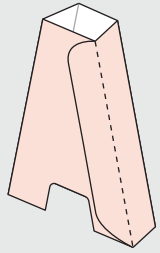
Cut out the **ARMS** and glue into place onto the appropriate glue zone.



**PRO TIP!**  
You can use the edge of a table or a ruler to make folding easier!

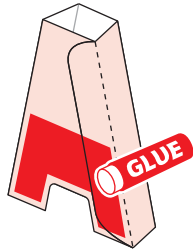

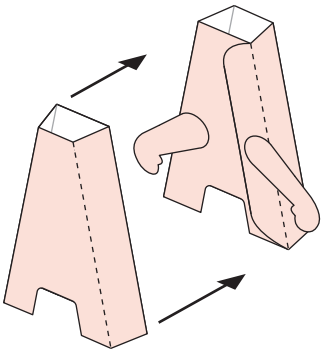
REPEAT steps 1-4 to assemble the **BODY FRONT** piece.

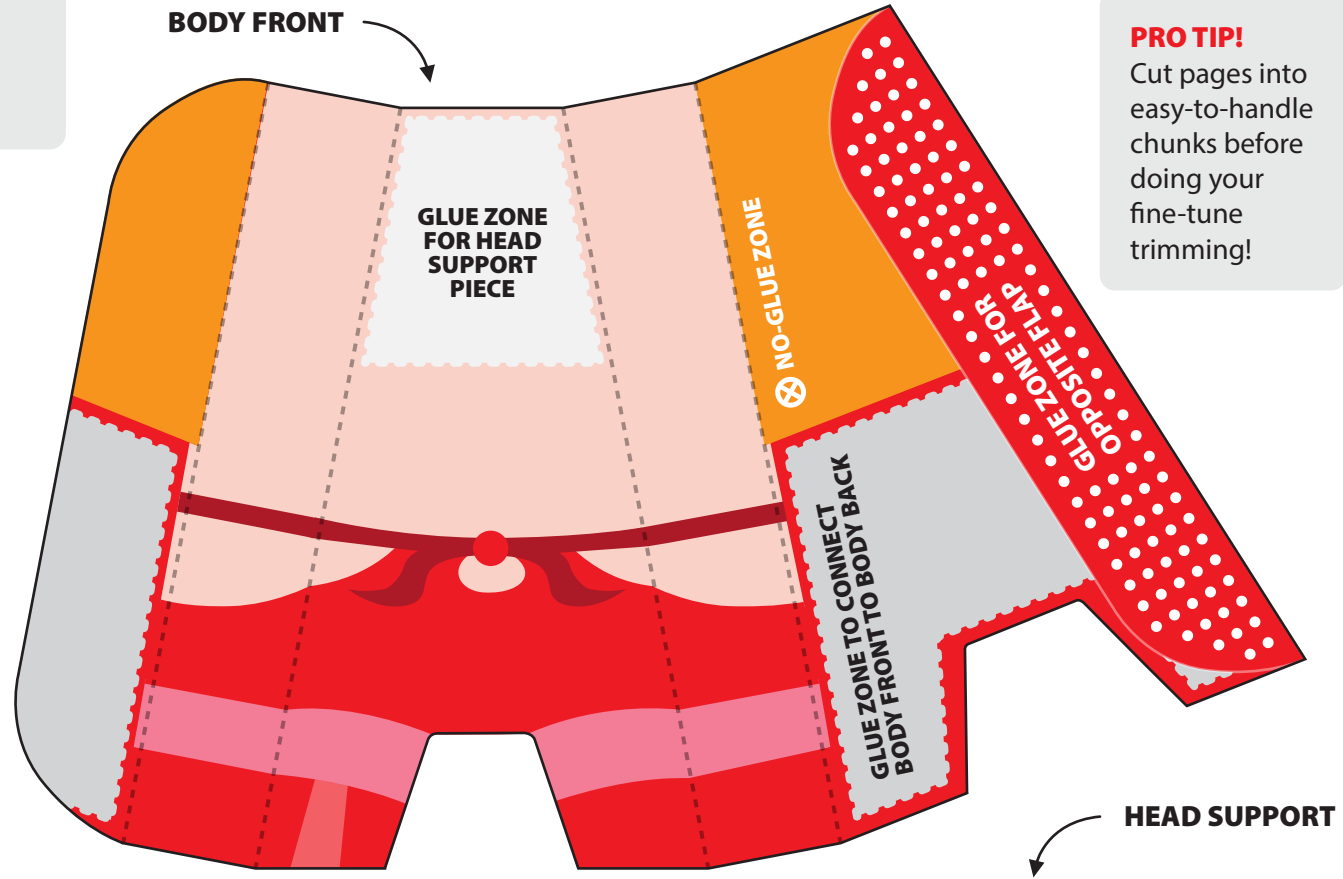
Add glue to lower half of the **BODY FRONT** glue zone. (Take care to avoid getting any glue in the orange no-glue zone.)

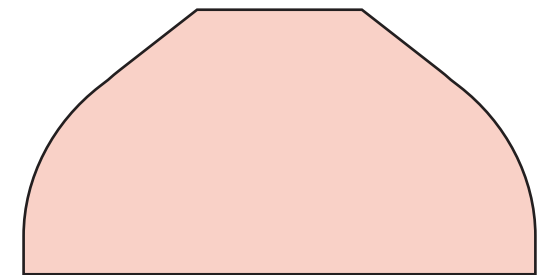
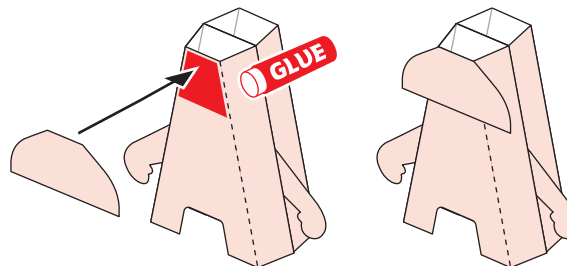


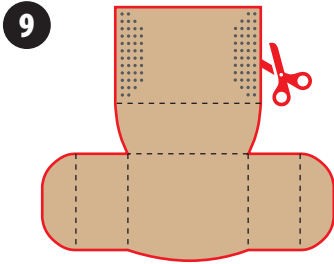
Connect the **BODY FRONT** piece and the **BODY BACK** pieces by “sandwiching” them together. Then cut out the **HEAD SUPPORT** piece and attach as shown.

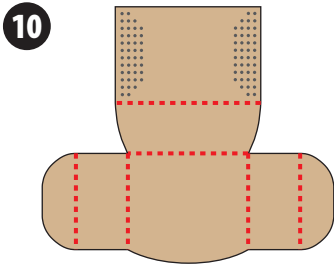


**PRO TIP!**  
Cut pages into easy-to-handle chunks before doing your fine-tune trimming!

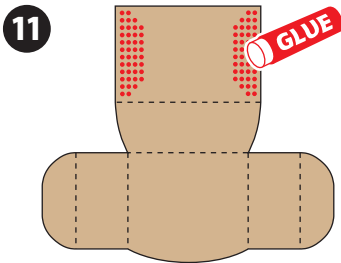




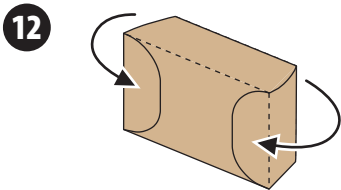
Carefully cut out the **HEAD BACK** piece with scissors.



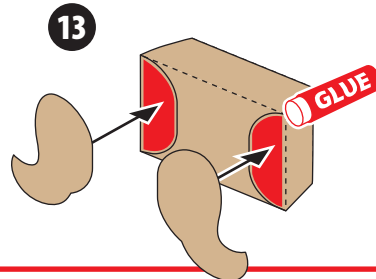
Make crisp folds on all dashed lines to create creases, then flatten out the shape again.



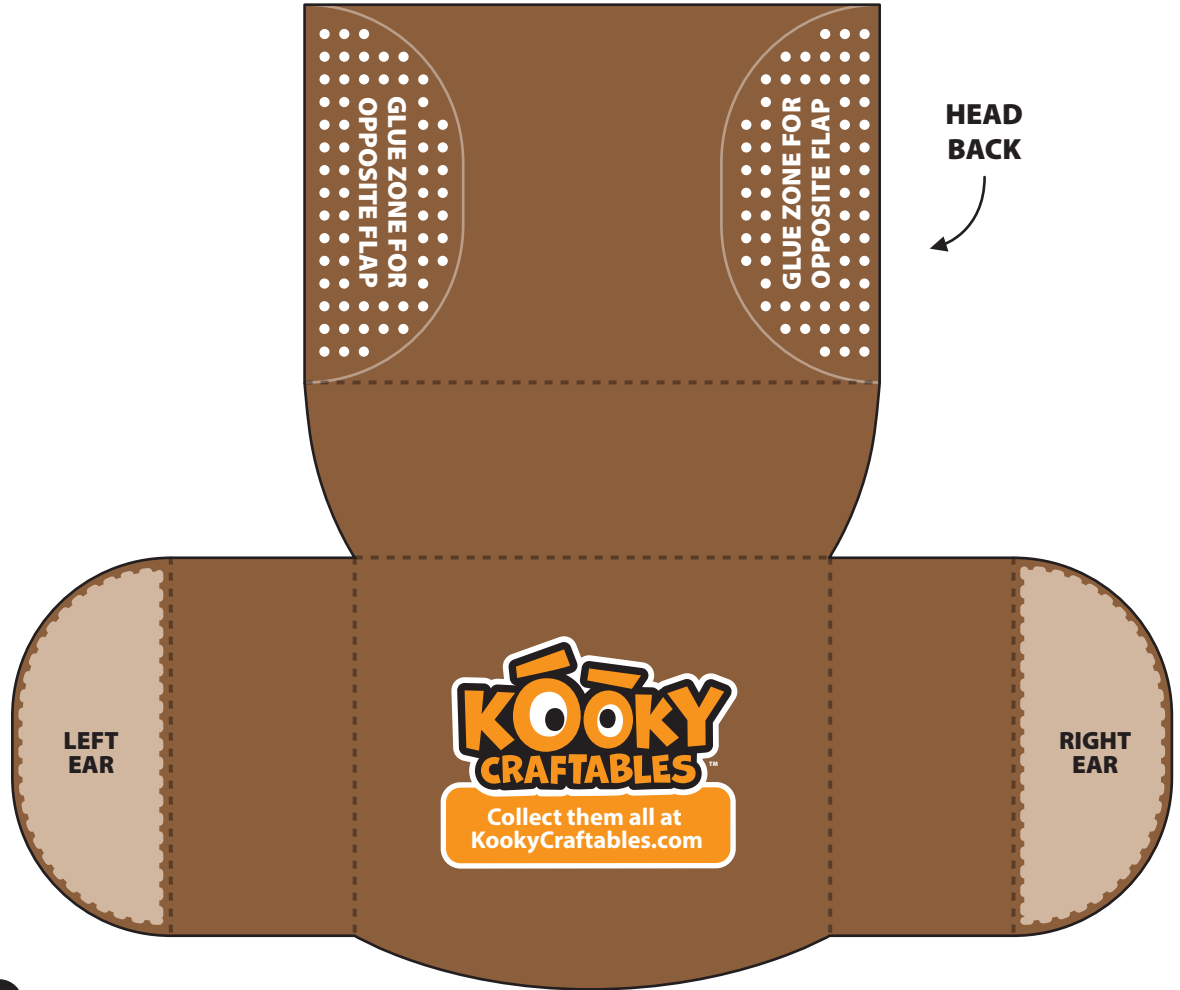
Using a glue stick, apply glue on the dotted glue zone.



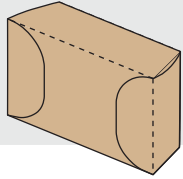
Fold as shown by securing flaps onto the dotted glue zones. The boxy shape has an open bottom.



Cut out the **RIGHT EAR** and **LEFT EAR** pieces from **page 6** and secure in place with glue where indicated.

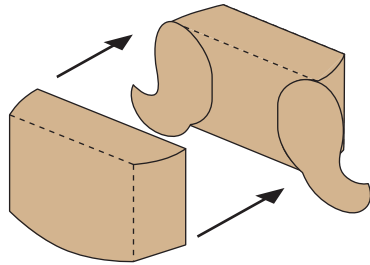
REPEAT steps 9-12 to assemble the **HEAD FRONT** piece.

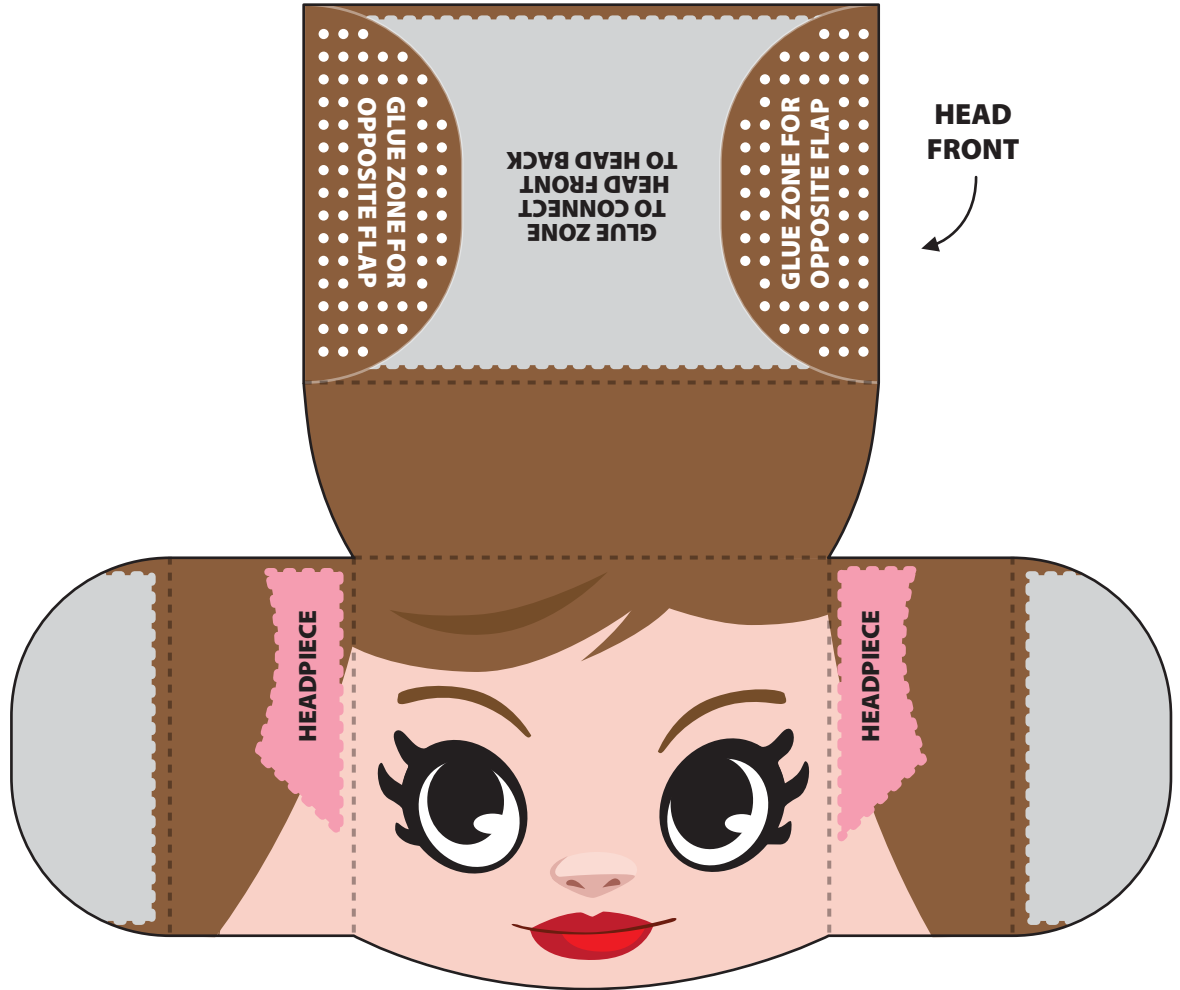
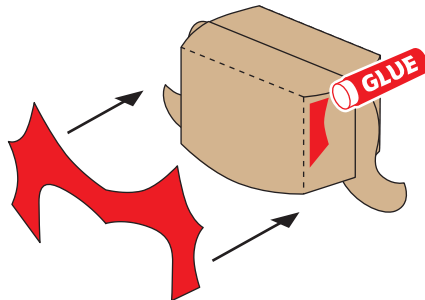
Add glue to the **HEAD FRONT** glue zone.

Then connect the **HEAD FRONT** piece and the **HEAD BACK** pieces by “sandwiching” them together!

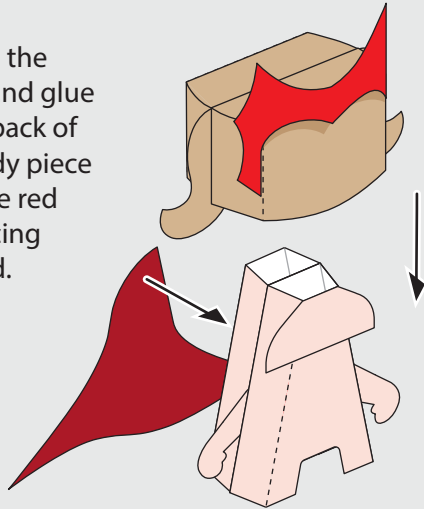

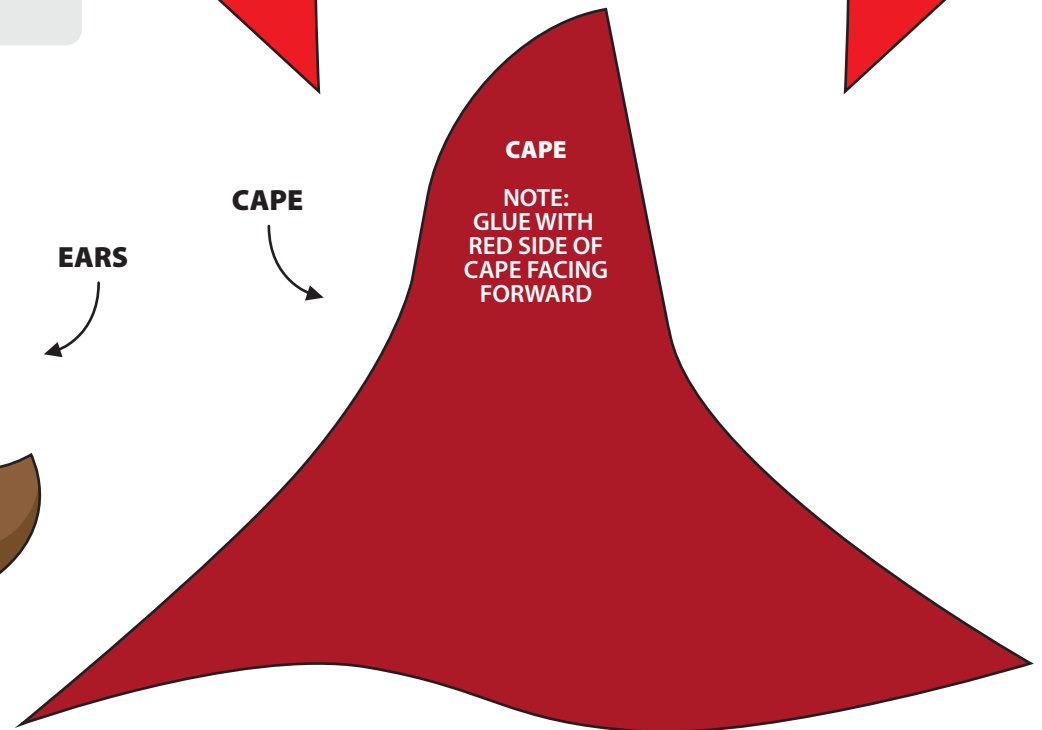
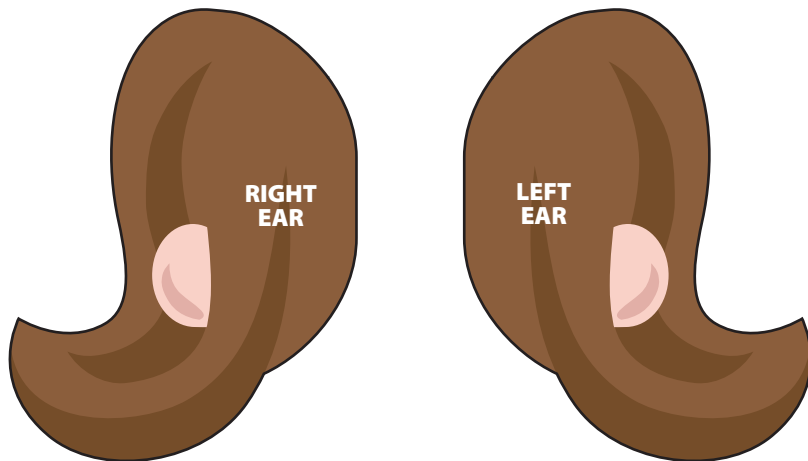
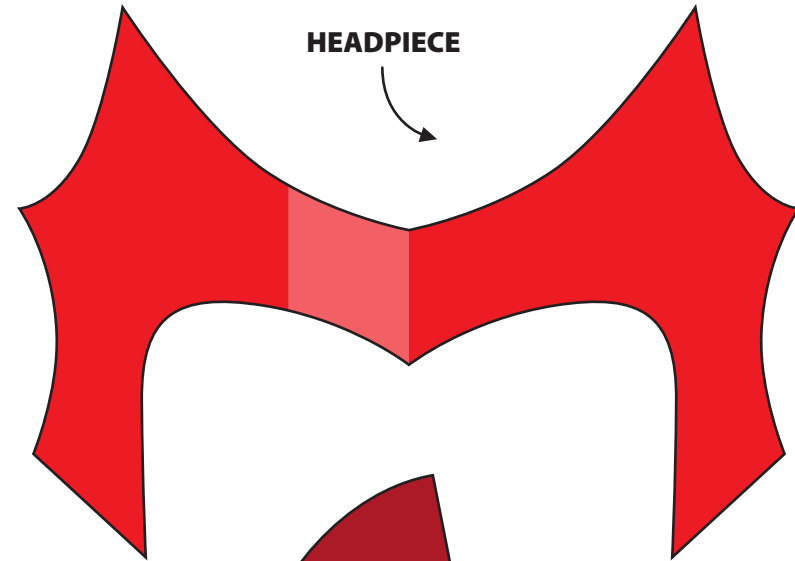
Cut out the **HEADPIECE** from **page 6** and secure in place with glue zones on each side of Scarlet Witch’s head where indicated. The headpiece will have a nice curve to it when applied.

**18 FINAL ASSEMBLY!**

Cut out the **CAPE** and glue to the back of the body piece with the red side facing forward.



To attach the **HEAD** to the **BODY**, all you need to do is slide it into the gap between the **BODY FRONT** and the **BODY BACK** pieces!
